

WTSC – Vancouver

New Business:

Talking with several carriers that were not at the Vancouver meeting there appears to be some confusion over the status of the WTSC. Be rest assured that the WTSC is a fully functioning committee and will continue to meet at the same time and location as the WNPO. Further down in these minutes is the new WTSC meeting format. Note that the meeting time is extended to include BOTH Monday and Tuesday. The FCC decision on July 16, 2002 has not affected the meeting or testing schedules.

A meeting is being put together to discuss the details for testing the 1K block number pooling. Neustar has been invited to attend. The meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, August 21, starting at noon PDT. Details to follow.

Ron Wuesthoff (AWS) – elected (railroaded) as new chair of WTSC
Joe Charles (Cingular) – elected as new co-chair of WTSC

I/C testing status will be given to the WNPO at the MSA level, not on a carrier level as recommended by the WNPO. Las Vegas test results will be shared with the WNPO during the September WNPO meeting. WNPO proposed trouble report will not be used by the WTSC. Carriers that are testing together in a market/MSA are expected to furnish a mutually agreed upon summary of the test results with two weeks of test completion and submit to the WTSC.

Carriers should determine which OBF version will be used for future I/C testing. Decision also needs to be made at the OBF on sunrise, sunset or flashcut of the .5 release to the 1.0 release. Carriers should approach their own vendors to push for closure of this issue at the OBF meeting next week. (Scottsdale, Arizona).

E911/911 Testing

Las Vegas tested using E911 Phase 0. Due to this ANI was not presented during this testing.

4.5.9 – 911 test case. If included, this test case should be noted as a wireline test case only. This test case is not a wireless standard.

Carriers that have porting/pooling test scheduled need to verify with their third party E9-1-1 provider and internal E9-1-1 support personnel that they are ready for MIN/MDN separation support.
