

WTSC Conference Call – 06/21/01

- **Introductions, agenda review**

- **Ad hoc test team meeting – GTT test cases**

Reviewed purpose and scope of GTT test cases. After some explanation on how GTT routing works, we decided to table this issue for a separate meeting. Mark Wood will head the subcommittee to write up these test cases. An overview of the test cases will be sent out to participants in the next few weeks. Other member's contributions are welcome.

- **Test Plan Revision 1.1**

Test case changes were sent out as Revision 1.1. These were mostly wording changes, since test cases are still being worked on. There was no objection to the proposed changes.

- **Test scenario layout** - Jim Grasser (Cingular) presented his example of test scenarios that would reference multiple test cases in the Inter-carrier test plan. Since test cases in the test plan do not incorporate the entire porting process, this will give service provider's a few examples of tests they may run. Other test scenarios outside of these examples will have to be created by the SPs themselves.

Action Item: Jim Grasser will provide a few more scenarios to put into document

- **ICC test cases** (presented by Teresa Patton's team in Virginia)

Ad hoc ICC test cases were revisited. Sprint had an issue with the line regarding *OSP sends confirmation of supplemental port request*. It was agreed that this should not be included.

Action Item: Teresa Patton (Cingular) will send changes of these test cases to co-chairs to be published.

- **Standardization of section 4.0**

Ad hoc team that wrote ICC supplemental test cases is also working on standardizing language on Section 4.0 of test document. We would like to have a draft ready to submit to test team for the next conf call. (July 26th).

- **Test index form**

Ron Whitson (Sprint Wireline) submitted test index form to track specific test cases. This is similar to Appendix A in test plan. All agreed this document was more helpful and we should replace Appendix A with it. Julie Groenen (Verizon Wireless) has responsibility to revise Appendix A. She will take the Sprint contribution and revise it to match our test plan. The assumptions in Appendix A will be moved to the specific test cases.

After we finalize and renumber test plan, Julie will create Appendix A based on the above criteria.

- **Walk on items**

- SLAs – Ron Whitson inquired about WTSC's policy on SLAs. We concluded that each company will need to verify if their inter-carrier test contacts will need an SLA to perform WNP testing.
- Document changes to test plan – We will need to add test cases to specify whether a ported number making a test call has been ported from wireline or from wireless. In addition, there is still the concern about section 4.3 (roaming wireline numbers – for example).

Action Item: Mark Wood will create a draft of addl test cases and changes to 4.3 Additional input from team members is welcome. This will be presented for discussion at next conference call.

- Tracking Action items – Discussion about how WTSC will track action items and also how they will share information with other industry teams.

Action Item: Mark Wood will create an action item/tracking list and publish by 6/29/01. This will have one set of action items for document changes and another for all other issues.

Action Item: Also, a report will be sent to WNPO co-chairs (Jim Grasser-Cingular & Bridgette Brown- Telecorp PCS) before their July 9 meeting in Ottawa giving a status of WTSC issues.

WTSC Overview:

Test Contacts (SPOCs) - 17 total (10 wireless, 5 wireline, 2 vendors)

GTT team will meet August 6 (PM) and August 7 (AM)

Major changes being worked on test plan

- 1) Section 4.0 standardization
- 2) Writing test cases based on “ported-from” criteria on ported calls.
- 3) GTT test cases – new team working on this
- 4) Section 4.3 – clarification and/or elimination of unnecessary test cases

Targeting August to complete MOST test case changes. We will need to start working on coordination efforts beginning in August.

IIR meeting (June 25) and CTIA meeting (July 17-18) on WNP. We hope to located new companies to attend WTSC meetings.
